- Philemon was written during Paul's first imprisonment in Rome. While under house arrest, Paul met a runaway slave, Onesimus. The letter is an appeal to Philemon to receive Onesimus back without punishment or harm.
- 1:2 Apphia was Philemon's wife, and Archippus was his son and the pastor of the church in Colossae.
- 1:10 Onesimus The name means useful. Paul plays on this name in the following verses.
- 1:16 The former slave now returns as a brother in Christ.
